Participation fee: Participating smallholder- farmers, and small-scale entrepreneurs will pay Tsh. 45,000/= as training fee per short course whereas each participant under the auspice of an organization or a company will pay Tsh. 180,000/= per each training course. Participants in partnership with foreigner(s) will pay equivalent to 200 United States of America Dollar for each short course. Smallholder farmers, and small-scale entrepreneurs who are not formally employed will need a letter of proof with genuine stamp from their local government leaders as evidence that they do not have formal employment and that they are only employed in smallscale- farming or - entrepreneurial acticvities. All participants regardless of their catefory will cover other cost associated with the training including transport, accommodation, meals, incidentals, training manual, certificate of participation, etc. Payment of training fee will be done upon arrival at the ICE, SUA. The minimum number for conducting each course is 20 participants. Where possible, participants are encouraged to team up to meet that minimum number.
